### All Souls' Day - Saturday 2 November

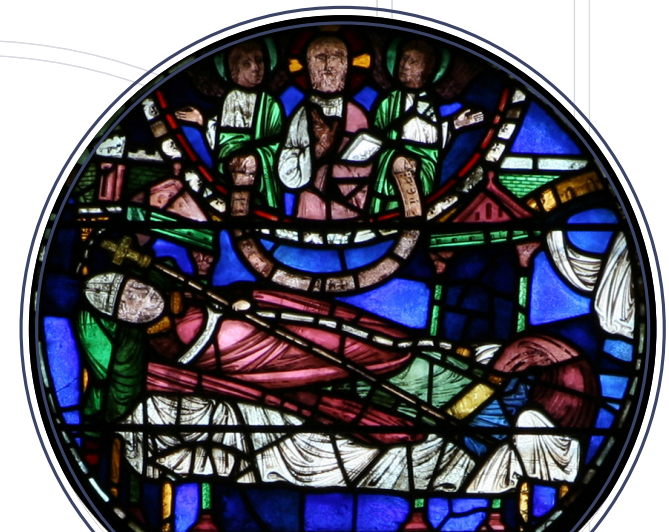
